

Instruction leaflet for *GroundGuard* Tiles - Gravel



- Clear the area of debris prior to installation.
- Measure area for correct number of ground tiles required. NB. Each pack of 20 = 3.04 square metres.



- Prepare ground and make level. Put down a layer of Type 1, 15 cm deep.



- Lay a membrane.



- Put down a layer of sand 2 cm deep.



- Clip tiles together, allowing for any cut sections to be the furthest away from heavily trafficked areas.



- Ensure the spike is pressed into the ground. Tiles may be cut to size using a suitable saw or knife.



- Finally, fill with 8-10 mm gravel or pea shingle.



- To remove, expose the locking element and use a flat head screwdriver to lever away from the adjacent tile. Replace accordingly, clipping together as per step 4.

WARNING

- Only suitable for pedestrian areas and light vehicle access.
- Not recommended for childrens play areas, around swimming pools etc.
