



## Injection Moulding Technician (Rotating shift)

### Job Summary

At FloPlast Ltd we design and manufacture a range of specialist plastic building and plumbing systems used widely in UK construction industry.

You will be responsible for the is responsible for the setting up, adjusting and tool changing of the injection moulding machines to ensure the efficient production of quality products.

This is a full-time position working Monday to Friday 3:00pm to 11:00pm with a daily paid break of 30 minutes (divided into one 10-minute break and one 20-minute break).

### Key Responsibilities and Duties

The responsibilities and main duties for this position include, but are not limited to:-

- To be responsible for all aspects of tool changing in the Injection Moulding department.
- Ensure that the cavities in the tools are sprayed with mould protection before removing the tool from the machine.
- To be responsible for all aspects of process control and setting in order to achieve the quality standard required. Regular QC checks are required to be completed on each machine in operation on an hourly basis.
- To work with the Process Engineer to reduce machine downtime within the guideline outlined by SMED.
- To work with the Production Team Leaders, Process Engineer and QC department to monitor, progress and maintain quality standards.
- To ensure that Process Setting Sheets are used to set each new job. These offer a 'guide' to the process condition required for each job, however, the Process Engineer will update the Setting Sheets as and when required.
- To ensure that the Production Schedule is followed and that the Barco Production Monitoring System is updated as required, i.e. tool changes, breakdown, colour changes, etc.

- To ensure that the Injection Moulding Machines are restarted after tool and insert changes with a minimum of scrap and in the minimum amount down of time.
- To understand work instructions, packing procedures and SOP's in order to complete the given task efficiently.
- Ensure that all tool changes and other maintenance work is done safely and within Health & Safety guidelines.
