As a Maintenance Engineer, you will be responsible for the routine, proactive and reactive maintenance of machinery within the Injection Moulding manufacturing areas.

Duties also include:

- Maintain all ancillary equipment and conveyors in the Injection Moulding and Regrind departments.
- Troubleshoot machine malfunctions.
- Develop a planned preventative maintenance (PPM) plan and ensure the timely completion of work carried out.
- Monitor equipment performance and maintain detailed maintenance records for each machine.
- Organise the receipt, identification and appropriate storage of engineering materials/spares.
- Ensure that a stock of essential spare parts is maintained on site to reduce downtime caused by breakdowns.
- Update records of work activities, tasks carried out, parts used through stores and to pass instructions on between shifts.
- Work closely with manufacturers, suppliers, and internal departments in finding ways to improve processes and increase machine reliability and performance.
- Support with general site maintenance and oversee site contractors working in the Injection Moulding department.
