Key Responsibilities and Duties

The responsibilities and main duties for this position include, but are not limited to:-

- Manage and support the development of the QC team.
- Train staff on all Quality related topics.

- Lead root-cause investigations using problem solving tools.
- Manage the NCR process, including defect handling (rework, reject, accept).
- Track and analyse KPIs and quality metrics and share findings with Operation's Team.
- Maintain close collaboration with Operations Teams.
- Support manufacturing and engineer teams to ensure quality is designed into processes and products.
- Drive Continuous improvement initiative to enhance Quality and reduce scrap.
- Ensure department welfare is maintained by risk assessing tasks and maintaining SOPs.
- Manage quality related communication with customers.
- Reporting of all incidents or accidents through the correct channel.
